On September 29, 2017 after a lengthy illness, the Lord called Ciarre' Nina (Peay) Stockett home to be with Him. Affectionately known as Ce-Ce Bumpkins, she will be truly missed.

A time to be born On March 29, 1985, at University Hospital in Baltimore, Maryland, Leevenzo I and Kellie Peay welcomed Ciarre' into the world. Their "little angel" was born premature (at 5 months) and weighed 1lb 10oz. From the start, she was a fighter and even though the doctors didn't expect her to survive, she persevered through many operations to defy the odds. Ciarre' was told that she would not be able to keep up with the other children because of her illnesses, but she refused to let illnesses limit her in life.

A time to live Ciarre' received Jesus Christ as her Lord and Savior at the early age of 14 at St. Lukes United Methodist Church under the leadership of Pastor Roosevelt Oliver. Continuing to fight, Ciarre' was successful in her fight to getting out of special education. In 2003, she graduated on time from Owings Mills High School. Although she was told she wouldn't be able to complete college, she went on to do so with a 3.8 GPA. Ciarre' also successfully completed a multitude of courses to become a Certified Medical Assistant (CMA) and a Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA). She was a Teacher's Aide at Owings Mills Elementary School, volunteer at University Hospital for premature infants, and a CNA at Future Care Nursing Home.

Ciearre' held a host of jobs including Giant, Wal-Mart and the Law office of Weinstock Friedman & Friedman. She married Dominic Stockett in September of 2013.

Ce-Ce Bumpkins always had her smile on her face and that beautiful smile was always encouraging others. Because of her warm heart, Ce-Ce quickly claimed others as her friends. Her sister, Leekiesha, referred to her as "Lemonade", often saying, "you either got sweet or tart, no in-between". Her brother, Leevenzo, referred to her as "The Enforcer", meaning if you owe her 10 cents, you better not give her 9.

Left to mourn Ciearre' leaves to mourn, her husband, Dominic Stockett; her parents, Leevenzo I and Kellie Peay; one brother, Leevenzo (Siobahn) Peay II; one sister, Leekiesha Peay; two nieces, Peyton and Paige Saunders; grandparents, John and Gloria Spencer and Frienzy Sr. & Lula Mae Roy; Uncles James (Lenore) Peay, Jerry Peay, Frienzy Roy Jr, Anthony Roy and John Spencer; aunts, Bertha Cathcart, Sheila Danette (Eric) Lewis, Nina Roy; two godmothers, Brenda McFadden and Kara Brooks; godfather, Kevin McFadden; Mentor, Tammy Poindexter, and a host of close cousins and friends.

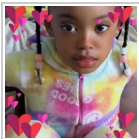

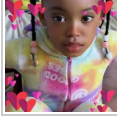

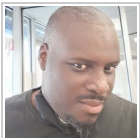
