DEACON CISERO GASQUE (affectionately known as Dec), was born on August 29, 1903 in the small community of Marion, South Carolina. He is the son of the late John and Isabella Gasque and is the second child of 13 children - four boys and nine girls. They all preceded him in death. He departed this life after a lengthy illness on Monday, September 15, 2003. He received his education in the public schools of Cedargrove, South Carolina and worked in the coal mines of West Virginia. He came to Baltimore and became employed as a plumber. At the age of 50, he joined the Macedonia Holiness Church under the leadership of the late Mother Josephine Pritchett. He was baptized in the name of Jesus and received the gift of the Holy Ghost. Later, he became a member of the Highway Church of Christ under the leadership of the late Bishop Fred Page and was ordained as a Deacon in 1982. He worked faithfully there for many years. In 1981 at the age of 77, he was united in Holy Matrimony with Mother Gussie Morgan, and they were married for 22 years. In 1994, he joined Greater St. Stephens Church of God Apostolic where he has faithfully worked until illness rendered him disabled. Deacon Cisero Gasque loved people and will be sincerely missed by everyone who knew him. He was a true and loving friend. Two sons preceded him in death and he leaves to mourn: his wife, Gussie Gasque; one daughter, Dorothy J. Dow; three sons, Johnny, Thurmon and Tommy Morgan; one son-in-law, James H. Dow; three daughters-in-law, Rosetta, Elaine and Brenda Morgan; a host of grandchildren, great-grandchildren, and great-great-
