CLARA LEE WASHINGTON SANDERS was the fifth daughter born to Johnnie and Ruth Washington on April 19, 1932 in Florence, South Carolina. Clara was educated in the Florence Public School System. She was baptized in Florence, South Carolina at Central Baptist Church at an early age, under the Leadership of Rev. Frank Williams.

Later she met and married J.B. Briggs, and to this union was born one daughter Ruby Briggs (both preceding her in death). She later relocated to Long Island, New York where she met and married George Sanders. Clara worked various jobs such as a nurse's aide. Later Clara came back to Baltimore and continued to work until her health would not allow her. As her health continued to decline, her sister (Bishop E. A. Mangum) and brother (the late Elder Jimmy Washington) decided it was best for Clara to move in with her sister Bishop Edith A. Mangum, where she lived until her passing.
