January 14, 1927 - September 28, 2003

Clarence Isaac Brooks was born in Big Woods, Maryland on January 14, 1927 to the late Isaiah and Rhoda Brooks. He received his education in Kent County Schools. Brooks, as he was fondly called, was married to Christine Brooks for fifty-one years. Yancie, who preceded him in death in 1993, was born to union. Brooks accepted Christ as his Lord and Savior at an early age. Though a quiet man, when asked, he always uttered "The Lord is good," even until his departure.
