After doing hair in Petersburg and Newport News, she decided to move to Richmond, Virginia.

Here she found her home. . .After working with her brother/uncle Billy at Groom's Rentals and Tailors and at the cleaners. She later found a job at the State Department of Workman's Compensation and was employed there until 2008 when she became disabled with a brain tumor.

Claudia had strong faith and loved her church, The Light Community Church, and was very active in the Golden Years Ministry, The Bread Ministry, Bible Study, The Hospitality Ministry, and sang in the choir for a while. Worshipping for Claudia was so important and it brought her so much joy and fulfillment. She attended church until recent months when she became bedridden.

Claudia loved music and loved to dance even as a little girl barely able to walk. She and her brother "Speedy" were natural comedians and liked to keep you laughing. Everyone that knew them has a joke or two to share as a memory.
