Claunita accepted Christ at the early age of 12. In 1996, she joined Temple of Judah under the leadership of Bishop Melvin Williams and was a devout member until her sudden illness. She was a faithful servant who lived her spiritual journey by demonstration - serving in whatever capacity the church needed. She was very close to Mother Williams.

At SCAN she played a vital roll and became a go-to person for advocacy, as well as resources with board members. She remained with SCAN until God called her home on March 27, 2019.

Cosmetology was her passion. Her adoring nieces loved coming to her house to get "made-up" and play dress-up. Nee Nee touched the lives of many people with her smile and gentle spirit. She will be truly missed.
