After graduating from Frederick Douglass High School, he served in the United States Army and was honorably discharged in 1946. After leaving the U.S. Army, he joined the Army Reserves and worked a variety of jobs while he attended Howard University. He later transferred to Morgan / State College, as it was known then, where he graduated with a degree in Mathematics. He married the love of his life, Josephine "[o]", on May 24, 1953 and also adopted her son, Gaylen. Of this union, their daughter, Donna, was also born. After graduation from Morgan, Bobby began working in the Ballistics Research Laboratory at Aberdeen Proving Ground. He retired from Aberdeen in 1986 after 30 years of employment, Bobby was always a generous man, never failing to give a helping hand to his family and friends: from silver dollars for the "little ones" at Christmas, to helping with mortgages, car payments, rent, and other things for the "big ones". He taught several generations of family members how to drive.
