The life journey of Clifton Johnson Scott was accomplished in a span of 92 well-filled years. Clifton, the son of the late Albert Scott and Lula Johnson, was born on January 18, 1913 in Chestertown, Maryland. He departed this life and entered into eternal rest on Wednesday, April 27, 2005. Clifton was educated in the public schools of Chestertown, Maryland. He honorably served his country in the United States Army during World War II. After serving in the Army, he returned to Chestertown, Maryland. In Baltimore he met and married the late Mazie Rita McGowan; from this union came two sons, Clifton and Earl. Clifton was one of the first African-Americans to own his own business in Kent County, Maryland. For over fifty years he owned and operated a Rubbish Removal and Hauling Company, until he retired and moved to Baltimore City. Clifton's business was a labor of love and not a job. He thoroughly enjoyed his work and was good friends with many of his clients. He was very outgoing, friendly and enjoyed spending time with his friends. He was well known in Kent County and loved the Eastern Shore. To keep alive and cherish his memory are: two sons, Clifton R. Scott and Earl Scott; one daughter, Doris Brown; two daughters-in-law, Valarie Scott and Julia Gaither Scott; son-in-law, Frederick Brown; twelve grandchildren, nephews, nieces and a host of other relatives and friends.
