Constance was born July 13, 1929, to the late Harry and Victoria Ford. She accepted Christ at an early age and was baptized at Pleasant View Baptist Church in Cumberland County where she also attended Cumberland County Public Schools.

After high school, Constance worked as a Nurse's Aide in New Jersey while staying with family before returning to Richmond to begin studying for her Certificate in Nursing. During that time, she met and married Gordon Speight, Jr., and from that union, five children were born. Constance was a loving mother, dedicated to her family; she worked for many years as a housekeeper which required her to ride public transportation (only had one vehicle) south of the river, five days a week. One day, Gordon, an avid hunter, purchased an old (manual drive or stick shift) car, we think his plan was to use the car to carry his hunting dogs when he went hunting; however, Constance, had another idea, and with the help of her neighbor, she mastered the "stick shift" and she was on the road!

Shortly, thereafter, Constance took a job as a CNA at Stratford Hall Nursing Center where she worked for many years and when she retired from Stratford Hall, she took a part-time position with Children's World Learning Center. The

children loved “Granny” and she loved the babies and often she would bring home pictures parents had given her of their children. Constance continued to work at the daycare center well into her seventies; and continued to drive into her eighties and by that time; except for driving herself and maybe one of her church buddies up to the Church, she was perfectly happy to let someone else drive. Constance had a friendly, easy-going spirit and was someone you could depend on...to know her was to have a true friend.
