



## Corine C. Ross

January 14, 1943 - December 22, 2016

On January 14, 1943, the Lord sent us one of His precious butterflies, Corine C. Ross, eldest daughter of eight siblings to the late John O. & Sarah C. Cross. She was born in Chestertown, Maryland and was called Home to be with the Lord on December 22, 2016.

Corine was educated in the Baltimore City Public School System. Early in life, she possessed a love for designing and putting her all into becoming a seamstress. Many prom goers, marching band members and wedding parties were adorned with Corine's creations. Not only did she enjoy sewing for others, but she also made sure that she never the same outfit twice. In addition to loving people, Corine loved cats and birds. Football was her favorite sport, although she enjoyed all sports. Another one of her specialties was cooking, especially fried chicken and cucumber salad. Traveling, dancing, and being around children were also a part of what Corine loved.

Corine was employed by Acme Pad and the Baltimore County Library. She received Christ under the leadership of Reverend William Rivers at New Bethlehem Baptist Church and was rededicated by Bishop Douglas Miles at Brown's Memorial Baptist Church. She later married Leroy Ross, Jr. and spent 21 years together.

Corine was preceded in death by son, Tyrone Cross (Tierra). She will be
