



## Trustee Curtis C. Bullock

May 23, 1939 - January 9, 2021

On January 9, 2021, Trustee Curtis Clifton Bullock departed this life as he took the hand of his Heavenly Father. Curtis was born on May 23, 1939 as the 2nd of nine children to the late Dempsey and Mamie Barnes Bullock. As a child growing up in North Carolina he was affectionately known as “Sweet” to his family and friends. Having grown up on a farm he was no stranger to a long hard day’s work. This work ethic instilled in him carried through to his adult years as he pursued and ultimately obtained his degree in Economics from North Carolina A&T University. His work career began as a part-time schoolteacher. He then accepted his first position in the insurance field which became his life’s work. He retired from Allstate Insurance Company after 30+ years of distinguished service.

On March 10, 1967, after a whirlwind courtship he married the love of his life Allie West bullock and they gave birth to three wonderful sons, TaVasta Bullock (deceased), Cliffon Bullock and Andras Bullock (Kristy).
