Cynthia Bernadette Carpintieri was born at Johns Hopkins Hospital as Twin baby B on December 8, 1938 as the second older of six children from the late John L. Martin Jr. and Emma M. Harris Martin. On Thursday, April 20th after a long battle with cancer and other illnesses, she transitioned to her eternal resting place coincidentally on the same day as her mother in 1987.

Cynthia started her education at St. Francis Academy Catholic School and went on to finalize it at Douglas High School. She grew up in East Baltimore, where she met and married her childhood sweetheart Joseph R. Carpintieri Sr. in 1958. From this union, they had 7 children. Careerwise, Cynthia spent many years working as a Control Lab Technician for SCM Chemicals. She later pursued various IT certifications from Catonsville Community College. This landed her a position as a Computer Operator for System House, which became one of her favorites. The last job she held was as a Receptionist at her son and daughter-in-law's beauty salon Blessings, where she was able to retire.

She loved animals and over the years found companionship with many different breeds of dogs. She was the life of the party and will be greatly missed.
