CYNTHIA ANN ROBERSON, The first child of seven, was born to the late Mary M. Roberson

(Nee Douglas) and Robert C. Roberson on March 28, 1942. She passed away on December 15, 2015 from a heart attack.

Cynthia attended St. Pius V Catholic School and graduated from St. Frances Academy in 1960. After graduation, she entered the Oblate Sisters of Providence as a postulate and in 1961 was invested as Sister Mary Bridget. Cynthia remained with the Oblates until 1972. During that period she obtained a BA degree in Sociology from Mount St. Agnes College and taught on the elementary and high school levels in several cities.

After leaving the order, Cynthia matriculated at Catholic University in Washington, D.C., receiving a Masters Degree in Social Work in 1974. Cynthia's professional career began as a technical assistant for social action activities in the Office of Social Development of the Archdiocese of Washington. She was subsequently appointed Executive Director of the Secretariat for Black Catholics by Archbishop William Baum, a position she held from 1957 to 1978. During the balance of the century, she was employed as a Clinical Social Worker with several organizations. Beginning in 2002, Cynthia worked first as a Clinical Social Worker and then a Marriage and Family Counselor at Winn Army Community Hospital, Fort Stewart, Georgia. In 2010, she returned to Baltimore, where she worked for Urban Behavioral Associates until retiring in 2013.

She is survived by her siblings Timothy Roberson (Cassandra), Patricia Anderson (Norman), Patrick Roberson (Angela), Mary Eileen Roberson, and Roseanne Plater (Jacques); also a half-sister, Robin Roberson. She is mourned by two aunts, Rosalie Roberson. She was preceded in death by one brother, Robert M. Roberson. She is mourned by two aunts, Rosalie Douglas and Vashti Bristol, nieces and nephews, other relatives, friends and associates.
