Daequon Darrin Glover, 24, of Richmond, departed his earthly life to be with the Lord Tuesday September 15, 2020. He was born September 5, 1996 to proud parents Tanika Scott-Jackson and Darrin Glover. He was lovingly known to friends and family as 'DJ'. He was preceded in death by his great grandfather Leon Hicks Sr. (maternal) and grandfather Herman Glover Sr. (paternal).

He attended Henrico County Schools and graduated from Highland Springs High School in 2015. Daequon was very athletic and proved as a powerhouse when playing recreational football in his adolescence. His coaches quickly recognized his strength and often played him in the position of running back as he secured many goals for his team. Daequon accepted Christ at an early age and was baptized at Hood Temple AME Zion Church where he was a lifetime member.

In January 2017, Daequon was recognized as a hero by WTVR News 6, for risking his life by kicking in the door to Freddie Beal's home to rescue him from his burning home in Highland Springs. This heroic act described the very essence of who Daequon was in so many ways. He was a protector and didn't think twice about placing himself in the line of danger to protect the life of someone he cared for. He was a loving, handsome and charismatic young man who loved to tell jokes and play around with his friends and family.

In October 2018, Daequon became the proud father of a beautiful baby boy named Dallas Canada, who captured his heart. He enjoyed his fatherly duties showing off Dallas to any and everyone by visiting family and friends. He also enjoyed spending his time repairing cars and working on electronic devices. Daequon was a devoted father, son, brother and uncle and always kept the love for them buried in the depths of his heart.
