Daisy Bullock Jones was born on December 6, 1948 to Warren Bullock and the late Dorothy H. Bullock in Vance County, North Carolina. She was the oldest of twin children (a boy and girl) born to her parents on this blessed day. The family moved to Richmond, Virginia when Daisy was about ten years old. In Richmond she completed her education in the Richmond Public Schools and graduated from Armstrong High School in 1967. She continued her education by taking classes at RPI (now VCU) for a couple of years. In 1972, she married Robert E. Jones, Jr. She joined Mt. Tabor Baptist Church as a young child and was a member for several years but as a teenager she joined Holy Rosary Catholic Church. In later years she returned back to her roots and became a faithful member of the Mosby Memorial Baptist Church family. She was a member of the Usher Board. Daisy worked several different jobs (Safeway, American Tobacco Company, Henrico Public Schools) during her lifetime but retired from UPS after working as a customer service representative for many years. Her hobbies included reading romantic novels, shopping and crocheting. Daisy participated in many organizations during her life time both in church and the community. The one she was most passionate about was her work with the Sisters Network Central Virginia, Inc. (a breast cancer survivorship organization). Sister Network, Inc. is committed to increasing local and national attention to the devastating impact that breast cancer has in the African American community. Daisy departed this life peacefully on December 4, at her sister's home after a year long battle with

kidney cancer. She was preceded in death by her husband, Robert "Buck" Jones, Jr., mother, Dorothy Bullock, and brother Calvin L. Bullock. she is survived by one son, Roderick D. Jones (Tonda), one step daughter, Traysi Beckwith (Rhamel), two devoted grandchildren; Britany D. Harris-Jones and Jayden I. Jones, father; Warren Bullock, grandmother.
