DAISY DARRELL LUMLEY (MCKAY) was born on August 11, 1926 to Bonito McKay Mcand Lona Satchell, in Swain Spring, St. Andrew, Jamaica West Indies. She was raised by her aunt Ethel McKay. She attended Red Hills Primary School. She was a kind, loving, compassionate and peaceful woman. Daisy met and married Izette Manning Lumley on June 29, 1955. He preceded her in death on December 15, 1994. From their union and partnership they raised ten children; Gloria, derrick, Fitzroy, Rylan (deceased), Monica, Irma (deceased), Hubert, Kenneth, Jenifer and Michael. Daisy was passionate about her parental responsibility. No task was too difficult for her to do for the betterment and care of her children.
