Daniel Robinson (Zoo) was born on June 25, 1921 to the late Warren and Sallie Robinson in Ninety-six, South Carolina. He entered into his eternal rest on Thursday, December 30, 2010.

He attended Brewer High School graduating with a scholarship in football. He briefly attended Betty's Junior College. In 1940, he migrated to Baltimore, Maryland.

On February 1, 1941, he met and married the late Geneva O. Turner. To this union two children were born. (Daniel Webster Robinson, who preceded him in death).

He accepted Christ as his personal savior at an early age. He was a member of First Apostolic Faith Church under the leadership of the late Bishop Showell. He believed in the ministry of giving and was a generous giver.

He enlisted in the United States Navy as a Steward's Mate 2nd Class serving at Pearl Harbor. He worked at Edgewood Arsenal and retired after 30 years at Bethlehem Steel's Blast Furnace.
