fishing, which he sometimes took his boys on outings to do. He also loved to spend precious time alone with Sonja on weekend getaways. Most of all, Darin was a family man. Nothing meant more to Darin than his boys, Khalil and Jordan. He loved them very much. As a child, Darin worked hand in hand with his dad fixing homes. He loved spending time with his younger brother, Vern, Jr. He loved to grill and just spend time with his family, having a good time, watching football on TV, or watching the boys play baseball and football and wrestling with them. He called his mother to speak with her every day, and she was the last person he spoke with before his passing. "He said, "I love you so much, Mommy," Ms. Chris recalled, "and I told him I love him, too." One of the things Darin was always known to say was, "Appreciate it!"

Well, all of those who knew and loved Darin appreciated him—and they will dearly miss him.

"He gave me his love, and I gave him my love," Ms. Chris said, "and I hope to meet him again sometime, someday."
