



## Darnell Antonio Williams

November 3, 1968 - July 16, 2006

DARNELL ANTONIO WILLIAMS was born on November 3, 1968, in Caroline County, Virginia. He departed this life on Sunday, July 16, 2006. “Tony” (as he was called by his family), attended Carolina County Public Schools, where he was an outstanding lineman on the football team. It was there that he also adopted the nickname. “Porkchop” from his peers. Tony was baptized in Jesus’ name at Ebenezer Church of Our Lord Jesus Christ in Richmond, Virginia, and later received the Gift of Holy Ghost. He attended the church faithfully and developed an apparent love for gospel music as a child. At the age of five, he began exhibiting signs of talent on the piano. From then on, his family endured countless nights of “practice” on the piano, keyboard and drums. Nevertheless, they continued to encourage him to cultivate his talent. His interest in music also prompted him to spend many afternoons in church practicing and developing his skills on the organ. It soon became obvious that he was no ordinary musician. In fact, he was extraordinary. Tony had no formal training, but was divinely inspired by God to play by ear (Proverbs 18:16). Many who heard him marveled at the way he moved his fingers across the keyboard. As a teenager, he became the organist for the Ebenezer Youth Adult choir. His reputation flourished. Tony became a mentor to other developing musicians and accompanied many local groups in Richmond and the surrounding areas. He also had the opportunity to interact with some well-known recording artists. Some of the people he accompanied include the John P. Kee Worship choir, Shirley Caesar, Timothy Wright, James Moore,

Milton Brunson and Karen Clark. He eventually became a promoter. On September 12, 1998, Darnell and his family became members of the Tabernacle, of praise Temple, COOLJC, where Bishop Mack D. Vincent, Sr. is pastor. Tony loved his family and enjoyed spending quality time with them. He will be remembered most for his cheerful personality, his individuality, his beautiful smile and of course, his musical talent. He leaves to cherish his memory: his wife, Venetia R. Williams; one daughter, Darnesha Williams; and three sons, Darnell, Dexter and Dustin Williams, all of Richmond, Virginia; his parents, Pierpont G. and Doris Y. Williams of Ruther Glen, Virginia. 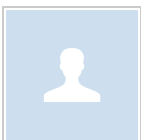
