Darreck was known in the music industry as P-Bodi and later changed his star name to Bodi-Roc. Darreck is a very talented young man who enjoyed people, going to Massanutten, his favorite vacation resort, amusement parks, and quiet time with his family.

He was affectionately called "Bud" by his family. He loved helping everyone. We are so proud of him, when his grandfather Thomas had a stroke in 2007, he helped care for him, especially after the death of his grandmother Lula.

Darreck became the proud father of two lovely girls, Nikaiya Aliya Jordan born March 9, 2003 and Sanaa Nevaeh Hodge born may 8, 2008. His girls meant the world to Darreck.

Darreck spent his life with a special friend "Jordan," who never left his side; she was with him at his hour of death on February 21, 2013.
