



Darrell Anthony Baylor

December 20, 1968 - September 4, 2020

“I in them and you in me—so that they may be brought to complete unity. Then the world will know that you sent me and have loved them even as you have loved me.”

In Baltimore, Maryland on December 20, 1968, God extended His goodness and mercy to Mary Francis (Lewis) Baylor and Ellis Emil Baylor Sr. by blessing them with a bundle of love named Darrell Anthony Baylor. Darrell remained a source of great love to his family and friends all the days of his life. He demonstrated his love in many ways, like how attentive he was to his mother, stopping by her house almost daily in her golden years to ensure that she had the things she needed or just to take her for a drive.

Baltimore was Darrell’s home all his life. He received his education at Mordicia Gist Elementary, Pimlico Middle School, and graduated from Forest Park Senior High in 1986. After high school, Darrell enlisted in the United States Navy. Following his discharge, he studied paramedicine at and graduated from Baltimore City Community College. His first job was at Baltimore Country Club, where he worked throughout his high school years; his last job, which he held for 15 years until cancer made it impossible to continue, was at Friends Medical Laboratory. While working at Friends, as providence would have it, Darrell met his beloved Kim Jones who quickly swept him off his feet

and to whom he would later propose. He was her “ride or die” and she was his in the sense that they could depend on each other through thick and thin. (We had to include that expression as a nod to old school hip-hop because Darrell loved to say he cut his teeth on old school hip-hop. We let him think that but we know he really cut his teeth on Grandpa Charlie playing the guitar and singing hymns like “Rock of Ages” and “Pass Me Not, O Gentle Savior”.)

Darrell was very loving, easy-going and playful. He had a special place in his heart for children and related to them easily.

During a difficult time following the loss of his father in 1990, Darrell found himself ensnared in a brief period of addiction, but God in his sovereignty used that dark time of recovery to show Darrell that he was a sinner in need of a savior. While attending Christian Life Church on Liberty Heights and Patterson Avenue, Darrell accepted Jesus Christ as Lord and entered Sonship.

Last fall when Darrell was diagnosed with non-Hodgkin's Lymphoma. Even though the Lord knew Darrell was near the end of his time with us, God showed His great faithfulness and mercy in a powerful way. When they prepped Darrell for chemotherapy, the large mass of cancer that had put him in the ICU for six weeks was gone. Nevertheless, Darrell was called home five months later.

The troubles Darrell faced at the end of his life were not reflective of his life. We thank God for the liberty He gave Darrell to enjoy the time he had and be a source of love and happiness to his family and friends.

In addition to his cherished Kim, stepdaughters Brittany and Quierra, step-grandchildren, and his mother Mary, he is survived by: his siblings Margaret (Dino), Donald, Charlene, Mona, Desireé, Carl, and David; his

siblings' spouses, Debbie, Donald, and Leslie; an aunt, Ruth (Delores) Crawley; a great uncle, Irvin Lewis Sr.; a great aunt, Reverend Marie Lewis; goddaughters Keyarra, Marteka, and Masharie; and a host of nieces, nephews and cousins whom he adored.

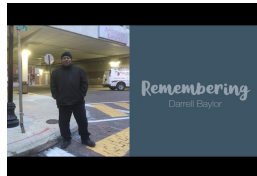
