Affectionately remembered as “Baby”, he completed his education in the Baltimore City Public School System. He graduated from Frederick Douglass High School in 1968. He furthered his education at the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene and the Community College of Baltimore, where he received his certificate as a Licensed Practical Nurse on August 17, 1979. He worked for the State of Maryland for thirty-three (33) years. He was employed at Spring Grove Hospital Center, Crownsville Hospital, Walter P. Carter Center and finally Spring Grove Hospital. He enjoyed working at the hospital and his care for his patients was top priority. He received numerous awards and citations during his employment. He presently served as President of the MCEA Chapter #9 at Spring Grove Hospital. He received his early religious training as a Jehovah’s witness and he was baptized in 1975. He was active until his school and work schedule prevented him from attending. He met Patricia (Pat) Brown in September 1968. On January 10, 1970, they were united in Holy Matrimony. From this union two children were born—David Allen and Patrice Danielle. He was a loving; generous, caring, family oriented man. He did everything he could for his family and acted as a surrogate father for his children’s friends. He was fun loving and always had a joke to tell. There are no words to express the exceptional love that he had for his family and his extended family. He loved to cook and will always be remembered for his

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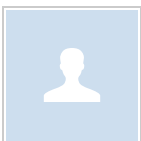
