David Hall Howard, Jr., son of the late David Hall Howard and Clara Elizabeth Howard, was born May 9, 1924 in Baltimore, Maryland. He departed this life on Sunday, December 30, 2007 after a brief illness. David was confirmed on April 2, 1939 at St. Phillips Evangelical Lutheran Church. He was educated in the Baltimore City Public Schools. After his formal education, David entered the Air Corps during World War II. David married the former Novella Jennings during his tenure in the military. Out of this union, three children were born, Deborah, Anthony and Delores Rose Howard who preceded him to live with the ancestors. In his later years, David married Roberta Howard who also preceded him in death. David added to his family a daughter, Terry Watkins. "Davy Crockett," as he was affectionately called by many of his friends and some of his relatives, was an active member of the Elks and VFW lodges.
