David's favorite hobbies were eating; painting; writing stories, poems, greeting cards and letters for the other residents. David also published a book, "Words and Thoughts."

David attend the Christian worship services at Levindale and testified to the goodness of Jesus Christ. David had many, many friends who were apart of the Levindale community. The residents, doctors, nurses, GNA's, dietitians, housekeeping staff, physical therapist, occupational therapist, and administration all loved David and he them.

David was preceded death by his birth mother, Donna Young; and brother, Dwight David.
