Debbie excitedly welcomed her 2nd grandson Demondtae Linton, who preceded her in death in 2021. Her two dear brothers Jeffrey and Anthony Anderson and her loving sister Carolyn Jackson also preceded her in death. Debbie offered nothing but endowing love, affection, and encouragement to everyone that she met.

At a young age, Debora dedicated her life to Christ and later became a member of Freedom Baptist Missionary Church, where she served as a Missionary, witnessing, touching, and affecting lives.
