God blessed Bessie and Jerry to bring forth their precious baby girl on May 17, 1952. No one could have ever known the incredible gem they were beholding. How could they? Just as Mary, the mother of Jesus, never imagined the value of her son, Bessie was unaware of the impact her daughter would bring to her entire family. Very much like a tanzanite, Debbie was an extraordinary gemstone who was influenced by her ability to demonstrate her “true color” when viewed through the lives of those she touched. The majority of her younger years were spent with her paternal grandmother, Fannie Hall, in Wilmington, North Carolina. This devout woman of God introduced her to the benefits connected with the joy received while serving others. Her spiritual appetite was first awakened through daily visits to the church with her grandmother.

As this incredible thirst for righteousness continued, Debbie was baptized in the Name of Jesus Christ at the Rehoboth Church of God in Christ Jesus Apostolic by Bishop Randolph Carr. As a teenager, she received the precious gift of the Holy Ghost at the House of God Gates of Heaven #3, pastored by Pastor Lawrence Thomas. Her adult church affiliation included the Apostolic teachings of Bishop William Barnes, Bishop Leroy Cannady, Sr, and Bishop Melvin Easley, Jr.. A clear indication of the continual growth of the Fruit of the Spirit living inside her. Debbie's humility and desire to "keep the peace" made an indelible impression on everyone who knew her. She will be always be remembered by the fruit that she delightfully bare!

At the age of fourteen, Debbie realized what became her life's passion of providing aid to those who were sick or helpless, while working her first job at the summer camp's infirmary. After graduating from Carver Vocational Technical High School with a Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN) diploma, she matriculated into the Community College of Baltimore and received an Associate of Art Degree in Nursing.

Following her calling, Debbie worked as a Registered Nurse (RN) for over thirty-five years. Her employment sites included Provident Hospital, Liberty Medical Center, and Sinai Hospital. She often worked six days a week succumbing to twelve-hour shifts. Debbie's nursing skills were admired by those who worked alongside her and her tireless efforts were treasured by the patients she cared for. She was never too busy to give medical advice or assist anyone in need. The nurses who received training under her tutelage, still testify of her superb work ethics. Because of her exemplary health care contributions, she was honored at the Governor's Mansion in 1996. Due to her declining health, Debbie retired early from Sinai Hospital; however, her desire to give assistance to those who needed it the most, never ended.

Debbie enjoyed co-parenting her grandchildren, Jordan, Joy, and Jewel, with

her daughter, Dynell and son-in-law, Glen. They were the loves of her life! She was an impeccable provider for her family, and no sacrifice was too great to give to them. Drawing from her inner strength, she graciously distributed compassion, gentleness, goodness, meekness, and temperance. Peace was priceless to Debbie, therefore, she sought it both night and day. She enjoyed spending time with her siblings, family, and those close friends who she embraced as sisters. Such interactions were a microcosm of her life's choice of putting her needs or wishes before her own; the classic definition of God's unselfish servant. While always esteeming others more than herself.

Convinced that to be absent from the body is to be present with the Lord, on Sunday, October 15, 2017, the angels of the Lord escorted our beloved and rare gem, Debbie, into the bosom of Abraham. Although her battle with cancer may have been painfully long, her relief was sweet and swift.
