wrong was THE BLOOD OF JESUS OR LOOSE SHEER.. Deborah was a true woman of God who let her light shine wherever she was, her smile would light up a room and was piercing to the heart. Deborah enjoyed and loved spending time with her family and friends, going to the movies, and traveling. She will be missed by all who knew and loved her.
