Delores Saunders (Missionary) was born to the late James Percy Saunders and Lula Mae Saunders. She was born on July 11, 1947 and raised in Baltimore, MD. She departed this life and went home to be with the Lord on January 9, 2021.

Delores graduated from Edmondson Westside High School in 1965. Not long after graduating, she became employed as a Dietician at Sinai Hospital of Baltimore in the Dietary Department for over 8 years. Thomas Jr. A member of the Soup Kitchen, her passion for helping others extended to the less fortunate and she would put on her apron and serve a hot meal, a kind word or clothing to individuals in need of assistance. She was a caring, giving and creative individual who devoted her life to Christ and her Church family. As a recognition of her servitude, her Pastor, Bishop Pender, appointed her to the Missionary Board where she dutifully served until she was incapable of performing her duties.

Delores, affectionately known as “Lorsey” and “Auntie, loved to entertain and cook for her family and friends. Everyone wanted to be at “Auntie’s” house. Delores was so stylish and loved fashion; adorned with a stunning hat, she was just a beautiful human being.

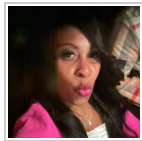
