Reflections of Life

The rest from labor for Reverend Delores McFadden Robinson Seay on Friday, September 25, 2020 in Richmond, Virginia.

A native of Richmond she was born to the late Willie Harrison McFadden and Cassie McFadden on January 29, 1934. She was preceded in death by her husband Deacon Peter L. Seay and two siblings, Ida M. Boisseau and Willie "Billy" McFadden, Jr.

She was educated in Richmond Public Schools and furthered her education at Evans-Smith Leadership Training Institute co-sponsored by the Samuels DeWitt Proctor School of Theology of VUU and Baptist General Convention of Virginia. She also loved her employers, Drs. Walter and Robin Mayer and their children whom she nurtured and loved as her own.

Reverend Seay was baptized by the late Reverend Charles F. Hinton in Seventh Street Baptist at an early age. She remained a faithful and loyal disciple, even as the church evolved. Under the pastorate of Dr. Arthur M. Jones, who licensed and ordained, she served as Associate Minister at Triumphant Baptist Church for many years. She was faithful to ministry as an Usher (No 2) Ministry, Sunday School teacher, Youth Ministry affiliate, and

Vacation Bible School Coordinator and teacher.

Reverend Seay touched so many people's lives. She was a mentor, motivator, believer, and teacher to many. She cherished her relationship with Jesus Christ more than anything and was committed to the purposes for which he called her. She served in many capacities: Volunteer Chaplin at Bob Secours Memorial Regional Hospital, Meals on Wheels, Volunteer Voter Poll Worker, nurturing and spending time many of her friends and the sick members of the church and community. She was a faithful member of the Tuckahoe Baptist Association. President of the Clergy Division, The Women's Auxiliary , Women's Mission Society, and the Women's League Incorporated.

Reverend Seay was married to Lawrence Calvin Robinson who preceded her in death and from that union four children were born; Gail, Martinez, Cathy and Karen. She was married to Deacon Peter Seay; and from that union one child, Crystal Michelle. She was the proud grandmother of six grandchildren, one devoted grandson, Nolan Seay. Remaining grandchildren are Danyel, Stacie, Lindsay, Blake, and Remar. She was also blessed to be a great grandmother of six great grands.

Rejoicing in her memory are her children; Gail Leeper (Michael) ,Martinez Robinson (Renee`) Cathy Lomax (Reverend Frank), Karen Robinson, and Crystal Seay, sisters, Jean E. Woodson and Madeline I. Franklin, and a host of other relatives and friends.
