While attending Coppin State College, Denise became a member of the Kappa Alpha Psi Sweethearts. She was pursuing a Bachelor of Arts degree at Northwestern University. While there she pledged the sorority of Alpha Kappa Alpha. Because of her illness, Denise had to leave Northwestern University and return to Baltimore where she worked for the city of Baltimore as a chemical operation's technician. Her religious life began at the tender age of 12 at Bethel AME Church, pastored by Bishop Bryant. Denise was also an active member of Mt. Lebanon Church, pastored by the reverend Moyd. Her greatest love was to help feed the body of Christ by working in the kitchen of Mt. Lebanon. Denise was loved by many people because of her fairness, kindness and genuineness. Her smile had the ability to sooth away a problem.

She was never too tired or bothered to help a friend or a stranger. She also had a giving heart. Denise's great love for children led to her volunteering to care for the handicap. Her warmth and realism will be sincerely missed by all and her many acts of tenderness will be cherished in the memory of many.
