Dennis Thomas Aldridge, Jr., son of the late Marie (McQueen) and Dennis Thomas Aldridge, Sr., was born on May 16th, 1922 in Chesterfield County, South Carolina. After a hard fought health battle and 94 years of amazing memories, he was called home to be the Lord on May 27, 2016.

He went on to study at North Carolina A&T College in Greensboro, North Carolina until he was drafted into the United States Army.
