Derek Herlen Lynch was born December 22, 1964 in Baltimore, Maryland to the late Herlen Vernon and Ruth Lynch. He was the 7th child from this union and was preceded in death by his older brother Dennis Lynch. Derek entered into eternal rest on Saturday August 8, 2020.

Derek was a juvenile diabetic and suffered permanent brain injury after being hit by a car at the age of nine. But he never let those obstacles hinder him from living his life.

Derek accepted Christ at an early age and was baptized at Calvary Baptist Church. He was a member of Dalton Baptist Church where he served as an usher and later joined Whitestone Baptist Church where he also served as an usher until his health would no longer allow him to serve. He received his education in Baltimore City public schools and graduated from Forest Park High School. Derek completed a course at the Control data Institute where he received certification in computers. He was employed by a Baltimore Restaurant as a cook and worked as a Security Guard for CSS earlier in life. Derek was nick named "Chocolate Man" later cut short to "Choc" because he loved chocolate and loved to "sneak" sweets. He thought he was Chef Derek while cooking fried boloney, fried potatoes, and boiling hot dogs. Derek loved to listen to oldies but goodies and loved to record music. He also loved to bowl and shoot pool.

He thought he was the ladies' man and loved to flirt. He was extremely talkative and very sociable; he could hold a conversation with anyone. Derek also had a very special way of putting people in their place in his own unique way.

Derek spent the last 18 months at Meadow Park Rehab Center. His brother-in-law stepped up and stepped in to assure that Derek received the proper care.

He leaves to cherish his memory four sisters Michele (John Robinson), Charvette, Yvette, and Tia Lynch, three brothers Herlen "Chucky", Troy (Lynda Lynch), and Derell Lynch, eleven nieces and nephews, twelve great nieces and nephews, and his best friend forever Dana Dyer.

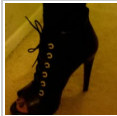
