



Dewitt Armstrong

June 11, 1939 - May 15, 2019

DEWITT TALMADGE ARMSTRONG was born to Charles I. Armstrong and M. Esther Armstrong on June 11, 1939 in Deal Island, Somerset County, Maryland. He slipped away from this life on May 15, 2019. Dewitt was the second child, and the eldest son out of nine children in the family. He loved the small fishing community where he was born, and the closeness of relatives in Deal Island. Dewitt's parents presented him for baptism at an early age in John Wesley Methodist Church in Deal Island.

Dewitt received his education in the Baltimore City Public Schools. He graduated from Paul Laurence Dunbar High School in 1958. Almost a year later, he joined the United States Navy and served until 1963 receiving an honorable discharge. His duty tours took him to Europe and the Mediterranean. He often reminisced about the time spent in Italy, and the freedom to move about that he experienced when not on board ship.

Following his military service, Dewitt returned to Maryland. He worked in various jobs, but primarily in security and public safety. This included the Maryland School for Boys and Coppin State College. He retired after years of service as a sworn officer with the Coppin State College Police Force.

Dewitt never married, nor had any children. He spent time with friends, his siblings, and nieces and nephews. We could turn to him for family history, and for updates on extended family members. He especially enjoyed music; from big band to jazz to contemporary music. He also enjoyed photography, though he admitted to being strictly amateur. We will miss his subtle wit and the glint

of mischief in his smile.

Dewitt was preceded in death by his parents Charles and Esther Armstrong, and his brother Clayton Armstrong.

He leaves to mourn: siblings, Evangeline Fuller, Roberta Smith, Charles F. Armstrong, Anthony Armstrong, Bernadette Owens, Orpha Brown, Lafayette Armstrong; brothers-in-law, Aaron Smith, James C. Brown; and nieces, nephews, cousins and friends.
