Diana Denise Randolph, 60, of Richmond, Virginia, 3rd child from the union of Trustee Herman Lee Randolph, Sr. and Deacon Queen Esther Randolph entered eternal rest on Tuesday, July 3, 2018. Diana, a graduate of John Marshall High School, class of 1975, pursued her cosmetology license after graduation. She was baptized at an early age at the Greater Brook Road Baptist Church. On July 14, 1975, she gave birth to her only child, Luciana Renee Randolph.

Diana then entered the workforce as mail carrier for the United States Postal Services. She then pursued a career at Phillip Morris, USA, where she worked as a machine operator for a number of years. She was a faithful and dedicated employee. After 25+ years of service, she went from active employment to Long Term Disability through her passing.

Later in life, Diana pursued music, song writing, and poetry. She was an active musician who released several CDs and music singles. She coined the name "Diamond Tiara" as her stage name. Diana wrote her first book of poems called "Good Fruit for Life", published January 12, 2016, available on Amazon, Kindle, and Barnes and Noble. Diana was a free-spirited person who was passionate about exploring life her own way. She was self-driven, motivated, and courageous as she traveled alone throughout the East Coast in pursuance of her dreams and aspirations. Diana was a giver and she

selflessly gave to many. Diana's pastime hobbies included Bingo, dancing, and playing cards with family and friends - in particular, "Mal-Mal". She lived her life to the fullest.
