DOMINIC OLUMUYIWA AKINWALE was born on August 9, 1951 in Cape Coast, Ghana to the late Ebun Sowemimo and James Akinwale. He departed this life Thursday, September 15, 2022 at Bridging Life Hospice in Sinai Hospital.

Dominic left Nigeria to come to America in 1972. He fathered a son, Patrick, just before leaving for America.

He studied at Norfolk State University briefly before relocating to Baltimore, MD to continue classes at the Community College of Baltimore. He developed a fondness for transportation when he started driving taxis and pursued courses at Lincoln Technical Institute in auto mechanics.

In October 1976, he married Annie Parrott. From that union, he became Dad to Tia Delly, his bonus daughter. Later in life, he brought his son Patrick to America to live with him.

Dominic strived for excellence in all he did. His love of transportation led him to operate cabs and become an established owner operator of cargo trucking and coach buses. After Patrick, Dominic fathered three daughters, Lola, Robin and Jennifer.

Dominic expected his children to exceed his expectations of excellence. It was never enough to get an "A" on report cards,

but an “A+” would be acceptable, if that was the best you could do. Mastering one skill was not enough, but you must acquire two or three. He never accepted “I can’t.” It was always, “you must try again.” This was his expectation from all of his children and the many “nieces and nephews” he guided and mentored.
