It hasn't been the same since you left us. At times, it's seems so very hard for me to live – to breathe – to be satisfied. Although, I know that God will help me with a sense of satisfaction (my home, job, etc) there is a part of me that is still incomplete because you are no longer beside me in the physical. However, I know that I must go on because I have to remain strong in order to raise our baby girl yet; I must say that it's hard to do so at times because I'm hurting inside. Speaking of hurt, Breniya misses you very much and she haven't stopped talking about you (we always say our prayers and I know you are there listening to her when we she says “I love you daddy”. She's your little girl and you will always be a part of her – a part of us. I also want you to know that I need you – I need your help because I have found myself isolating myself again. You used to comfort me when I was going through something well I need you now. I've been praying and asking for help. I have been asking God to help me every single day. On His time, he is gradually answering my prayers - he sent me back to our old job and they have been there for me. It's going to get better - I can feel it. In addition, I want you to know that I always loved you and was so very proud of you. I also want you to know that I love still and miss you so very much - you were my world. You, myself and our little precious baby girl: we were “like” the perfect family (well at least in our eyes - ha). Nothing else mattered when all three of us were together and I can promise you that our bond will always remain. Well baby – I kind of miss being able to write you letter and poems because you always lend your ear – you always listened. Now, I have a new victim (my sister- Cheryl) to talk to until God blesses me with another companion. Breniya and I are still attending church and she loves attending children church. It's helping us a great deal but there is no time limit on getting over you. I just wish it never had to end like this – having to see you helpless in the hospital for almost a year and having to see your murderer found NOT-guilty. Those are the two things that I hold on and I still stand firm on my feelings of this tragedy that
