Donald graduated from McFarland Junior High School in Washington, DC; received his GED and was enrolled at Delaware State University for 2 years on a football scholarship.

He was an avid Washington Redskins fan and would refuse to let anyone say negative things about his team. His house was decorated with Redskins mugs, Redskins caps and a Redskins flag in his bedroom.

Donald loved to go fishing. His brother, Johnie would often travel to Richmond to go with him. Although he had both legs amputated and was on dialysis three times a week, he lived his life to the fullest. On a daily basis his neighbors would see him driving his wheelchair to the corner store.

"Chef" Donald loved to cook. He worked at Perkins Restaurant in Denver, Colorado where he was promoted to head chef. He last worked at Uncle Bob's Restaurant in Richmond, Va. Donald was thoughtful. He always sent birthday and Christmas cards to his family and friends. You could also count on him for a "How are you doing?" phone call.

His parents, William Fields and Bessie J. Bell-Fields and two brothers; William M. Fields and Angelo B. Fields preceded him in death. He leaves to cherish his memories, his daughter, Tracy Norman (DC); granddaughter, Jacqueline S. Norman (DC); two sisters, Shirley M. Fields (DC) and Dorothy M. Fields (DC); one brother, Johnie M.
