Donald L. Poole was born on May 4, 1933, the only son of the late Cecelia Poole (Lewis). He departed this life on September 17, 2009 after a lengthy illness, while residing at the Loch Raven Center Nursing Facility. Donald received his education in the Baltimore County Public School System. He attended Bragg Elementary School and Sparrows Point High School. Donald played basketball and sang with the Glee Club. Donald graduated in 1952 and immediately went to work at the Bethlehem Steel Corporation. Shortly thereafter, he was drafted into the U.S. Army, from which he received an honorable discharge. Donald was previously married to Thelma R. Poole (Mitchell), and this union produced one child, Karen Poole. On July 25, 2005, Donald received salvation through the Lord Jesus Christ and was baptized by Rev. Dr. Frank M. Reid, III.
