Donald Yancey, a retired Westinghouse Aerospace Engineer and Westinghouse Visiting Professor at Morgan State University, passed away in the early morning hours of September 17, 2008, on his 77th birthday. At the time of his death, Mr. Yancey resided at Lorien Nursing and Rehabilitation Center in Columbia, MD. Mr. Yancey was a native of Atlanta, GA. Mr. Yancey earned a Civil Engineering degree at Howard University with the Class of 1958. Prior to completing his undergraduate studies, he served in the U.S. Army as a member of the 513th Military Intelligence Group (1954-1956) in Frankfurt, Germany. Mr. Yancey held positions as: · Aerospace Engineer at Rockwell International in Los Angeles, CA · President and General Manager of Fairmicco Industries (Washington, D.C.), a subsidiary of Fairchild Industries, · Director of Marketing, Control Data Corporation, · Defense Marketing Manager – Westinghouse- Pittsburgh · Project Manager – Westinghouse- Baltimore. Mr. Yancey participated in the Westinghouse Visiting Professor Program detailed to Morgan State University in Baltimore beginning in August, 1990. He retired from Westinghouse January, 1994 and enthusiastically continued his affiliation with Morgan State University until he was disabled by a stroke in May, 2001. Mr. Yancey was predeceased by two sons, Mark Allen and Scott Earl and is survived by a daughter, Lisa Joyce, all three are offspring of his prior marriage to Joyce McLendon (nee). Other survivors include: 3 granddaughters – Ashley Nicole and twins, Quinn Anique and Qalin Alena; a sister – Barbara Render of Fremont, California, 3 brothers

– Ray Yancey of Macon, GA, Kenneth Yancey of Atlanta, GA and Ronald Yancey of Columbia, MD. Other survivors include numerous nieces & nephews, a brother-in-law and 3 sisters-in-law.
