DONNA MARIE JACKSON, transitioned to eternal life on January 14 at 3:46 P.M., after being removed from life support.

Donna was born on May 15, 1963 while her parents, William and Edith Jackson were stationed at Chanute Air Force base in Rantoul, Illinois. She was the third of four children. After moving back to Baltimore, Maryland, Donna coursed through the public school system, attending Forest Park High School, finally graduating from the PTC Vocation School.

As a child, her father nicknamed her "Frannie Fink". Later shortened to "Fink", that nickname stuck, everyone called her by that name.

Fink worked in the Hospitality industry, specializing in food and beverage; that specialization suited her because she was so fastidious about everything. Even at the last, while in the nursing center, she would make her own bed and straighten her room every day.

Fink never married or had children but she enjoyed loving relationships and would dote on all children. Her nephew Freddie was her first love and she treated him as her own. Neat, clean and pressed, Fink was often compared to her grandchildren, Mary Mines.

Donna was fiercely private and independent, so much so that in her later life, she often communicated with the family through her sister Diana, whom she describe as the family spokesperson. Donna accepted the consequences of the decisions she made during her life, but she never complained.

She lived her life "Her way".
