Doris became a member of Trinity Presbyterian Church on September 22, 1963. She was Ordained a Deacon on December 21, 1988 through December 31, 1991. She worked in the church on other occasions helping where needed. She joined Tots and Teens Incorporated where both of her children experienced many social and cultural events.
