



## Doris E. Stovall

October 4, 1934 - November 1, 2004

Doris Elaine Stovall was summoned to eternal rest on Monday November 1, 2004 in Baltimore, Maryland. She was 70 years old. A native of Rochester, New York, Doris was the daughter of Charles and Pearl Coleman (deceased). A graduate of West High School in Rochester, Doris married Donovan Stovall in 1952, and out of their union, two sons were born, Stanley V. Stovall of Baltimore, Md. and Darrell J. Stovall of Phoenix, AZ. Doris was a resident of Phoenix, AZ. For 43 years. Among her many accomplishments: in 1962, the first African-American to integrate employment at a major retailer in downtown Phoenix and the first African-American woman to be certified by the State of Arizona as an electronic assembly instructor. As a teacher for the majority of her adult life, Doris taught electronic assembly at the Phoenix Jobs Corps; supervised and helped build the Apache helicopter at Hughes Helicopter in Mesa, AZ.; developed and facilitated the electronic assembly teaching curriculum at Rio Salado College. She was also a contributing editor at the Arizona Informant Newspaper in Phoenix. Doris was a member of Tanner Chapel A.M.E. Church in Phoenix. In addition to her sons, Stanley (and wife Yolanda) and Darrell, Doris is survived by her sister, Shirley A. Clark of Rochester, N.Y.; 6 grandchildren: Amelia Finley, Darrell Jr. And Derrick Stovall of Phoenix, AZ., Stacy, Stefan and Summer Stovall of Baltimore, Md.; 2 great grandchildren: Shelley and Delvon Stovall of Phoenix, AZ., and a host of family and friends.
