DOROTHY SUSIE BOOZE, was born July 15, 1927 in Baltimore, Maryland, the daughter of the late Annabelle Cherry and late Louis Keene, who was a descendant of Harriet Tubman. She departed this life on January 22, 2012.

She was educated in the Baltimore City Public School System and the Apex school of Cosmetology.

She was baptized at Sharon Baptist Church and later became a member of Mount Zion United Methodist Church.

She was employed as a teacher's aide in the Baltimore City Public Schools at Franklin D. Roosevelt Elementary School and later as a Physical Therapist at what was then Baltimore City Hospital. She also worked at home as a cosmetologist.

She was a lifelong resident for over 50 years of the Greater Mondawmin Community where she worked as a member of the Greater Mondawmin Community Neighborhood Association. Over the years she worked as a community organizer along with Senator Ralph Hughes, States Delegate Keiffer Mitchell, as well as countless others.

She supported her son Marshall in all of his musical endeavors; she became a

surrogate Mom to all of his fellow musician friends.

She is survived by four children: Marshall C. Booze Jr., Anthony E. Booze, Constance Thomas Rogers, and Kevin S. Thomas, (a fifth child Johnny L.
