Dorothy was fiercely dedicated to her family. She often hosted family gatherings, which included her delicious coconut and chocolate cakes. Dorothy found great pleasure in embarking on annual road trips to church conventions with her girlfriends.

In addition to that, Dorothy had a fondness for visiting casinos with her sisters, Joan and Bernice. Her most favorite activity was enjoying breakfast with her daughter every weekend. Shopping was another passion of hers, and she always made sure to dress impeccably. Dorothy departed this earth on November 1, 2023, days shy of her 80th birthday.
