Dorothy received her education in the Brunswick County School System in Southport, NC. She was very athletic, and considered a stellar basketball player during her High School Years.

In her adult years she relocated to Baltimore Maryland, where she rededicated herself to the Lord and served as a member at the Olivet Baptist Church. She would later finish her career at The Chimes organization located in Randallstown, MD devoting 20+ years of her life to caring for individuals with mental and intellectual disabilities. Dorothy (Nana) was also a loving grandmother and great grandmother, known to many as Dot, (Mama Dot), and Mama Jones. Those who encountered her, knew her to be a loving, caring, giving, and kind-hearted woman. The epitome of the term "Big Momma" no matter who you were, she always offered a home cooked meal and a place to lay your head if needed. She was the most unselfish person and often made sacrifices for everyone she loved, without any mention. Many would call her an Angel in Disguise.
