DOROTHY MARY NEALE was born in Baltimore, Maryland to the late Samuel and Henrietta Curtis Neale. Dorothy departed this life on November 28, 2014. Dorothy attended St. Peter Claver School. While there, she was taught to crochet by her second grade teacher, Sr. Raneria and this craft became a life long hobby. Later while attending St. Frances Academy, Dorothy learned to play the violin and joined the orchestra. Dorothy also worked at St. Peter Claver Church as secretary during her high school and college years. She also served as a Sunday School teacher and secretary of Blessed Virgin Sodality and volunteered for the Fish Fries. She attended Morgan State College for one year and transferred to Coppin State College from which she graduated in 1955.

Her teaching career started in 1955 at P.S. #108 which was located on Presstman and Gilmor Street. When P.S. #108 closed due to a fire, she went to Gilmor Elementary P.S. #107 which is where she taught until her retirement in 1993. Dorothy returned to Morgan State College and received her Master's Degree in Elementary Education in 1976. She was an extremely dedicated teacher who initially taught grades first through third. Later in her career she became a specialist as a Hi I Reading Teacher. She was also voted "Teacher of the Year" on May 6, 1990.

Her favorite holidays were Christmas and Halloween, and she would decorate her classroom and dress appropriately for each holiday party. Upon retirement, Dorothy volunteered to duplicate by hand the old church records.

She also worked at the Josephite Archives.,

Dorothy was a loving and caring person and would help anyone in need. This was seen in the way she cared for her uncle, George Neale, until his death.

She was preceded in death by her brothers Joseph and Paul i Neale.

She leaves to cherish her memory: sisters, Isabelle Neale and Catherine N. Thomas; devoted nephew, Richard Thomas; and a host of nieces, nephews, relatives, and two special friends, Catherine Green and Sarah Abraham.
