October 7, 1942 - February 24, 2004

Douglas Anthony Curtis was born October 7, 1942 on the Feast of the Holy Rosary to the late Thomas E. and Evelyn C. Curtis. He went home to God on February 24, 2004 after a lengthy illness. During his illness he took great pleasure in saying the rosary daily with his sister Janice. Doug was a devout Roman Catholic who received his Sacraments at St. Peter Claver and St. Pius V Catholic Churches. Doug attended Carver vocational Technical High School where he studied Radio and Television Repair. After graduation he attended Morgan State University. In the 1960's Doug became active in the Civil Rights Movement. As a member of the Civic Interest Group he participated in many freedom marches and sit-ins and was even arrested while protesting against segregation in restaurants. He was passionate about the fight for freedom and equality and did not waiver about taking a stand even before he was old enough to vote. Douglass worked for the Social Security administration, (SSA), for 41 years. He retired in January 2004 due to illness. For the last 13 years Doug worked as a Disability Examiner in the SSA Atlanta, Georgia Regional Office in the Disability Quality Branch. His friend and coworker Jackie Davis-Belt called him "Two Cats" for his ability to bounce back after illness. Doug was an excellent athlete who played softball on several SSA sponsored softball teams. He later coached a softball team, the Raiders, in the Catonsville Recreation and Parks Banneker Masters League. Doug was also an avid Pinochle player. Doug always had a smile and would take great pleasure in telling outlandish jokes to make other smile as well. He will be

missed. Tony, as his family called him, leaves to cherish one brother, the Hon. Tom Gene Curtis of Baltimore, three sisters, Joan Curtis, Janice Curtis Greene and Mary Curtis of Los Angeles, Baltimore and Charlotte respectively; two brothers-in-law, Paris Greene and Martin Olsen; one sister-in-law, Juanita Curtis, nine nieces and nephews and a host of relatives, coworkers and friends.
