Doyle Jerome Lord, 64, of Richmond, Virginia, passed away peacefully on December 19, 2025. Known affectionately as “Butch,” he was born on July 15, 1961, in Brooklyn, New York, to Shirley A. Lord and the late Doyle B. Lord, Jr.

In his early school years, Butch was in IGC classes (Intelligently Gifted Classes). He was good at mathematical equations (like his dad) to the point that years later when his niece was in high school, he helped her solve her trigonometry equations. A proud graduate of Brooklyn Technical High School, Doyle carried with him a deep sense of curiosity and it was thought that he would become an engineer.

Butch began his career at the New York Telephone Company and did very well and thereafter he held a variety of jobs over the years. He was definitely book smart but the New York City streets were brutal so in the late 1990’s he relocated to Virginia. Butch had two strokes in which the second stroke rendered him partially paralyzed and dementia set in but he knew who his family was especially when Mom sang “A bushel and a peck and a hug around the neck.” Butch liked playing Chess and in his later years played the card game of “I Declare War” with his sister. Butch was loved as we made sure that we advocated for him and was there

every step of the way in his journey. With prayer and hope that he would overcome his battle but more importantly, it is God's will that will be done.
