His employment included working as a Floor Tech with the Baltimore City Public Schools, a Thrower with Baltimore City Trash Remover, and Home Improvement projects for family and friends. Durant or "Wiggie" as we affectingly called him was a smart dresser. He knew how to be fashionable for all of our special occasions, and he proudly wore his suits to a tee. Wiggie was a great talker as well, and would talk for hours about his many adventures. He would even act them out, and we enjoyed it all. Eighteen years ago on October 14, 1998 Durant entered into Holy Matrimony with his wife Marlene. Their best days were filled with fun by listening to music, dancing, traveling, and working together painting and doing home renovations. Out of this union God blessed them with three wonderful daughters, and he spoke about them with much affection. The Holy Scripture tells us that children are a heritage from the Lord, and God also blessed Durant with a fourth daughter.
