He was born on January 31, 1978 in Baltimore, Maryland at University Hospital. Dwayne grew up in a Christian household. While visiting Institutional Baptist Church of Forestville Maryland, Dwayne expressed that he 'found God'. He gave his life to the Lord and was baptized as a member of Emmanuel Temple Church. He ushered, sang on the choir and assisted with various tasks around the church. Dwayne had a personal relationship with God, the Father. Dwayne was educated in Baltimore City Public Schools. He was a gifted student who excelled in art, science and math. Dwayne had a talented hand that was able to make drawings come to life. He designed a hat and T-shirt line with a friend call DDChron. After joining the Marines in 1997 he furthered his education in Explosive Ordinance and trained to be an EOD tech. Dwayne had a mild mannered personality with a quiet strength. He always had a positive word or smile to offer. Dwayne was known to joke or find the humor in every situation. Dwayne was born into a family that issued nicknames for everyone. His grandfather, John Thomas Williams (affectionately known as 'Papa') issued Dwayne the name 'New Man'. Some of his other nicknames were Newly, Newly Pooh Bear, Dwaynie Pooh, The New and Wayne. He was everyone's baby. While stationed at New

River Air Station in Jacksonville, North Carolina, he met the former La'Star Collins. They dated for a while and developed an affection for each other that created a love called Malachi Ein Williams. The married couple were raising their son in Havelock, North Carolina while Dwayne was intermittently away serving his country.
